



3. You don't know which of your deeds will take you to paradise either, subhan Allah. Perhaps your eyes are looking at some big deed which will take you to paradise, but you will see that removing harm from the path is what benefitted you. It's important to do different deeds. For example, someone might think Bilal (may Allah be pleased with him) doing adhan would take him to paradise, but it's his two units of prayer after wudhu which benefitted him more than anything else. This makes a person increase in doing good deeds because you don't know which of your deeds will increase you in ranks and will benefit you on the Day of Judgment. This is also true with friends and children.
