Allah describes the people who behave in this way. They were not ignorant people, they

The ones who have a Book must be upgraded, and be better than others. But look what they did. They gave away their knowledge, as if it was the trade, and they purchased misguidance instead. This showed that they loved it, and preferred it over everything. They should have been true to their knowledge and guidance, but they preferred disobedience over obedience, misery over happiness, misguidance over guidance.

They should have been confident of the guidance of their Book, and guided others as well. Instead, they tried their best to mislead them, working on this evil intent. This is a very wicked action, especially from someone given the Book. This is because they are following their desires.

So Allah is warning the Messenger صلى الله عليه وسلم and the believers not to be deceived by them. Don't be like them, specially if have been given knowledge. So it is a caution and a warning.

Allah is the Guardian for the believers, and He tells us the tricks of the disbelievers. Allah is the All-Knower of the enemies, and He will protect you, but you must understand their tricks. Believe in Allah and His knowledge. It is enough for you that Allah is your Guardian. He brings happiness and success for His slaves. He will give you victory against your enemies, and with make you attain all the goodness. How? By disclosing the tricks of the enemies. This is protection for you. The more you believe in Allah, the more protection you will get.
