The journey of nurturing through the Qura'an is universal. When there is no outer interference, the nurturing is perfect. The Qura'an reforms and puts everything into its place with wisdom.

The story of Musa عليه السلام unfolds from the time when

he left Madyan after completing his contract of working for 10 years as a shepherd. He left with his household, and on the way to Egypt, they lost their way.

It was night, dark and cold. Suddenly Musa saw a flicker of a flame, at a distance, in a valley. He told his family to wait for him while he investigated, and he could probably find someone to show them the way, or atleast some fire to keep them warm and light their way.

They needed warmth and guidance for their travel, and Allah gave them something better, the guidance of the akhirah. Being lost and cold was a nurturing towards searching for warmth and light, which led Musa عليه السلام to talk to Allah. Allah nurtures people through their needs and things which are lacking in their lives.

The valley wasn't a frightening place, it was comforting, sacred and blessed. It was a special place, because Allah called Musa عليه السلام from here, and spoke to him here. Musa عليه السلام was also given the prophethood, and his miracles of his staff which transformed into a snake, and his hand which

became glowing white. Allah prepared Musa by telling him it was a blessed place.

Glorify Allah by removing all negative thoughts, imperfections and faults from Him from your heart. Allah glorifies Himself. Whatever Allah does to His slaves is a nurturing, free from all faults. All the actions of Allah in the universe are good. Allah nurtures the universe with His blessings. Whatever you go through is part of your nurturing. It is important to make tasbeeh, to keep moving forward.

Allah is the One who is worthy of all worship, the Jee to whom all the creation submits. He is Irresistible, none can oppose His might. He is the All-Wise, He puts everything in its place by His wisdom. Allah knew by His wisdom that Musa was the best one to talk to, and for the task ahead, and with His might, He sent him to Firawn. You must rely on and incline to the One who is the Most Powerful. Don't be afraid, everything is in His hands, and happens the way He wants. Continue on your path, relying on Allah, even if there are aggressive enemies to face.
