Ibrahim عليه السلام is tilted as خليل الله, the close friend of Allah. He is also from the group of أولوا العظم من الرسل, the messengers of great determination. He was given so many challenges from Allah, and he succeeded in all of them. He raised the foundations of the Ka'abah. He was one of the first to be called a Muslim. He made du'a for his offspring.

Allah nurtured him with a direct command → أسلم. This is special nurturing. The higher the faith, the more swift and strong the nurturing.

Islam means submission and surrender to Ar-Rabb, with the heart and limbs. It is a total change, submission from all aspects. The heart must submit to all the decrees, and be pleased with the nurturing.

When the heart is humble to Allah, the limbs will follow automatically. We may think this is a command for the believers, but it is the first and last command. When you submit to your Rabb, you change completely.

How did Ibrahim عليه السلام respond ? He submitted with his heart and limbs and utterances, to the Rabb of all the worlds. What makes a person surrender and change? When he goes through nurturing, the whole universe is also nurtured. This is the impact of His Lordship. Your submission brings purity, sincerity, and love. Sometimes you go through a situation and Allah takes care of it, and this increases your love and submission. Be in harmony with the universe with your submission.
